## YOUTH MINISTRY COVENANT

## Definition:

A covenant is a solemn oath made before God to create and enter into a new relationship. Unlike a legal contract, a covenant is a statement of faith in the One who unites us, and in the love, which binds us, and a promise to uphold the integrity of the relationship for the sake of all parties.

Scriptural Basis:

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus..."

(Philippians 2:3-5)

Youth Ministry Covenant:

Through our unity in Christ we acknowledge each other's gifts and contributions to the group. We are all dependent upon one another to maintain an atmosphere in which love and spiritual growth can take place. Every member of this youth ministry is expected to behave in a manner that is consistent with the values and teachings of our faith. We will show our respect and love for one another by following the rules below.



I will attend and participate fully in the entire event, unless otherwise agreed upon with the youth leader(s).

I will respect the event premises at all times. I understand that vandalism, disturbing the peace or inappropriate behavior as determined by the youth leader will not be tolerated. I understand that I will have to pay for any damages that I cause.

I will not smoke or consume or distribute DRUGS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, or TOBACCO products of any kind before, during, or after any youth ministry event.

Cursing and gossip are not acceptable.

I agree to stay with the group at any off sight event, unless small groups are permitted to break away. In the event that small groups are allowed, I PROMISE to stay in that small group at all times, and a youth leader(s) will know my approximate location. I will be punctual when returning to the large group.

I agree that all personal items brought to youth ministry are my responsibility. Any lost, stolen, or broken items are not the responsibility of the youth leader(s).

I acknowledge that all rules outlined in this Covenant and by the youth leader(s) for that event will be respected and followed even in the small groups.

I understand that by breaking this covenant during a youth ministry event I'm not only disrespecting the group and the youth leader(s), I'm disrespecting myself, my family, and my church. In this event I realize that my parents will be notified. I know that I can be excused from an event if the youth leader(s) feel it is necessary; in this event my parents will be called to make arrangements for transportation home at the expense of my family.
